Kids are usually introduced to the five senses in Pre-K or kindergarten, a precursor to the more advanced anatomy lessons they'll learn in upper grades. For now, they need to recognize the senses as sight, sound, smell, hearing, and touch, and identify the body parts that go along with them. These fun activities will help them do just that!

Exploring the Five Senses through a cut and stick activity. Make five groups with your students. Assign one of the senses to each group. That group will be in charge of completing the worksheet that goes with their sense and reporting back to the class. Review the rules for group work time: 1) Talk to your group about the topic 2) Listen to others 3) Take turns.

1. Introduction: The teach-

er will start the lesson by asking the students if they have ever heard of the five senses. If they say yes, ask what they know about them. If they say no, then say, "Well today we are going to find out what the five senses are!"

2. Body: The lesson will start off by having the children do an activity.

Materials Needed: 2 1/2 cups flour, 1 packet of unsweetened Kool-aid, 1 cup of salt, 2 tablespoons of vegetable oil, 2 cups of water. Heat the water up (in the microwave or on the stove). Add in the kool aid and the oil. In a separate bowl, mix in 2 cups of the flour and all of the salt.
